Lessons from Implementing Collaborative Surveillance

Objective:

To translate Collaborative Surveillance approaches to audience-member needs, and provide complementary country and regional experiences that showcase how the Collaborative Surveillance approach has improving detection and response to emergencies and integrated data and systems.

Anticipated outcomes

- Participants understand the benefits of collaborative surveillance, especially how it supports integrated data, better decision-making and increased resilience of public health surveillance and lab systems.
- Participants can apply learnings from other countries to shape their own priorities.
- Participants understand the adaptive responses that will be required for success.
- New or strengthened collaborations with country partners and donors.
